Lauren Alexis Fisher Birders can dress up in any clothes they want and they will still see birds, but choosing the right bird clothes can really help you see more birds easier. Exactly what to wear from birds will vary depending on the season and habitat, and savvy birds plan their field wardrobe carefully to maximize their birds. There are several factors to consider when you choose bird clothes. Comfort: First of all, the clothes for the birds in should be comfortable, which will encourage you to stay in the field Often preference is given to non-clothed clothing in light tissues, and dressing in layers allows you to change the temperature during the day without interrupting the birds. Clothing Wear well in so there will be no wear or blisters. Function: Functional clothing is a must in the wardrobe of any birders. Cargo pants with deep pockets to hold a laptop or box guide are useful, and strap loops can hold other tools. Specialized bird vests are popular and come with a wide range of pockets to keep the gear instead of a field bag. Shoes should have good ankle support and adequate tread for different walking conditions. Color: Good birders know to wear clothes that will blend with the habitat they will explore, and they choose camouflaged colors or muted shades of brown, green and gray. Avoid bright colors, especially white, which is the color many birds are used to seeing as a warning of danger (think white tail feathers dark-eyed junco when the bird flies away). Choose colors to match specific habitats such as light green or brown shades for birds in open rural areas or meadows, dark shades for birds in a shady forest, or even blues and gray for pelagic bird rides. One exception is if you have birds in the park or garden explicitly to see hummingbirds: in this case, bright colors such as orange, red, pink and yellow can help bring the tiny birds closer for a better species. Noise: Birds have an exceptional ear and no matter what clothes you wear, they will know that you are there. At the same time, avoiding clothes with loud sounds such as corduroy pants or nylon jacket can minimize the noise you make in the field and allow you to get closer to the birds. When choosing shoes, make sure they don't creak with every step. Also avoid any zipper pulls, buckles, or other accessories that may rattle when walking. Environment: The exact habitat you plan to be birds in will affect what clothes you choose. Long sleeves and long pants are most useful for blocking excessive sun and discouraging insects in all habitats, while waterproof clothing, especially footwear, is a good idea in wetland habitats. Thermal clothing is important for winter birds, while light fabrics that promote air circulation are a reasonable choice for summer or tropical birds. No matter where you will be birds or what you hope to wear, remember: Wear a hat to shield your eyes and break the contour of your head and face for better camouflage near cautious birds. Avoid choosing clothes that reflect ultraviolet radiation. Birds can see ultraviolet light and will react to the reflection of clothing. Always choose clothes you don't mind getting dirty, so you can take the steps necessary to see the bird better, even if it involves rubbing against bushes or stepping into the mud. Bring a change of clothes if it's or at least change socks and shoes to switch in case of wet feet or other discomfort. The hunting season in many areas falls directly into the heart of autumn migration, and birders planning to visit areas near hunting areas must take steps to stay safe. When a bird is during the hunting season, always follow the recommended guidelines Safe hunting clothing such as wearing a bright hat or pinning strips of bright fabric to regular bird-watching blankets to make you more easily visible and recognizable to nearby hunters. The best bird clothes are not only comfortable but useful as well, and by choosing the best clothes for birds, you will be able to see more birds more closely than you imagined. For this reason, knowing the measurement of your bust, waist and hips (in inches) can be an incredibly useful tool to have at your disposal. While you may be a size 6 in one store and a size 2 in another, your consistent measurements will help you find the right fit and the right size from store to store, brand to brand. Admittedly, every manufacturer has different standards for its size, so it can be so difficult to get your size right, especially when you shop online. We recommend using a size chart to get a good sense of what your size probably is, but when buying from an online store, look for the right guide to help you make the best choice. In addition to using the general size charts we've included in the slideshow ahead, be sure to consult with the manufacturer or retail size chart to find the exact size for the various brands. Also, note that many online retailers have either live or email customer service to chat with you about the sizes and fit. Here's how it's done. Use a fabric tape measure and a full-length mirror. Take measurements of undressing or in light clothing. Pull the tape measure snugly, but not too tight. Keep your hands on your side and each take measurements for better results. And don't forget to stand up straight! How to measure your bust: Stand upright and measure around the shoulder blades, under your armpits and throughout the entire part of the bust. How to measure your waist: To find your natural waistline, bend your body to the left or right. You want to measure this time. It should appear above the hip bones and below the chest. Tape measure should be cozy, but not tight. How to measure your hips: Measure the full part of your hip (usually about 7-9 inches below the waist). This measurement should include the buttocks. Make sure the tape measure is flat against your body and parallel to the ground. Note: The following diagrams are intended for use in general guidelines Consult size charts from individual stores and manufacturers to get the perfect fit. The US misses the clothing size chart. The range of misses is even indicated by sizes that increase by two, such as 4, 6 and 8. This range of sizes is commonly used for everything from mass-market clothing (J. Crew and Gap) to designer and modern labels (Gucci, Theory, etc.). With designer labels, 00 is usually the smallest size, while most moderate or inexpensive clothing sizes start at a size 0 or 2. In modern clothing, it is not uncommon for sizes to only go up to 10 or 12. Note that knitwear is often in size from XS-XL in size to misses, not numbers. U.S. Junior Clothing Size Chart. The sizes of juniors are designed for young women and are marked by uneven sizes from 1 to 13. Sizes for juniors tend to be thinner in hips and bust than skip sizes (to match the growing, youthful body shape of adolescents). Junior clothes are often trendy and cheaper than women's clothing and are often made to be more like fast fashion, which is only in style for several seasons.
